

PBP SITE GUIDE - BRICK ARCHES - LIGHTWEIGHT

GUIDE 2021
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- 1. Your arches will arrive on site shrink wrapped and strapped on a pallet. Concrete arches are structural so care should be taken when off-loading. Once unwrapped, pointing can be completed. Every arch will be labelled with the plot number as shown in the image below. Trolleys or roller tables allow a single worker to manoeuvre on a full size panel, avoid damage to edges & corners were possible.

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3. Before lifting your arch into place ensure the brithe weight of the outer leaf masonry above.	ickwork and lintel is installed. Lightweight arches are non-	load bearing and require a steel lintel in place to carry
