HORIZONTAL LAP WEATHERBOARD 101



Storage

- Boards MUST be stored under a breathable cover on the pallets on which they are supplied
- Any temporary transportation hoods MUST be removed to release any trapped moisture
- Failure to do this is the main cause of efflorescence

Timber Battens

- Vertical 38mm x 50mm (min. size) battens, spaced at a maximum 600 centres
- A strip of EPDM should be applied to protect the batten, especially under joints

Cutting

- A guillotine gives the cleanest possible cut
- After cutting, wipe away dust with a clean, dry cloth
- Cutting and drilling MUST take place in a dry, well-ventilated environment

Ventilation

- Is critical to ensure correct performance of the system
- **Minimum** open cavity of 30mm required behind weatherboard
- 20mm **minimum** ventilation gap at window and door heads
- 10mm **minimum** ventilation gap at window cills and soffit
- Use Vent Profiles provided to prevent insect/rodent ingress

Fixing

- Minimum 30mm overlap required
- Board fixed at least once to every support batten; joints MUST occur over EPDM covered batten
- Allow AT LEAST 150mm between bottom edge of first board and the ground



Finishing

 For best results, use colour matched Torx screws when fixings will remain visible

Touch Up Paint

- Only to be used on cut edges, any overspill should be removed immediately
- Not recommended for use on the face of the weatherboard

Screwing - RECOMMENDED



Hand Nailing

 Nails MUST be stainless steel ring shank, minimum size 2.8 x 45mm with 7-10mm head

Pneumatic Nailing - NOT RECOMMENDED

 The misuse of a nail gun is the most common cause of chattering/loose boards
